

Kids read for "Kasey" & Adults read for "Teacher".

Note: This script requires that kids and adults read for the appropriate role. More mature sounding teens can read for "Teacher" if they like.

It's Show & Tell time in Kasey's grade 1 kitten class today. There's a buzz of excitement in the air, except for one kitten. Kasey. Sweet, gentle Kasey seems more nervous and upset than excited.

INT. KITTY SCHOOL - GRADE 1 CLASSROOM

Kasey bashfully walks up to Teacher, who's standing at the front of the class setting the space up for Show & Tell. Kasey gently tugs on Teacher's sleeve to get their attention. Kind and gentle Teacher squats down to Kasey's level.

1	TEACHER Oh! Hi Kasey. What's up?	1
2	KASEY Ummmm...Teacher? I can't do my Show & Tell.	2
3	TEACHER Oh, ummm...Did you forget it at home?	3
4	KASEY No. (beat) I forgot what it's called.	4
5	TEACHER Hmmm...well, why don't you "show" us what it is, "tell" us a little bit about it and maybe the name will come back to you.	5
6	KASEY (Brightening) (Giggle) That's exactly what my Show & Tell does! It comes back to you!	6

The class grows quiet and all the kids start to pay attention to Kasey and Teacher's conversation. They're all curious.

Kasey runs back to the desk, takes a boomerang out and holds it up.

7 KASEY (CONT'D) 7
My grandma bought it for me in
Australia.

8 CLASS 8
Wow/Woah/Cool!/What is that?!

9 KASEY 9
If you throw it the right
way...BOOM...it flies right back to
you. (GASP) Wait! That's it! It's a
BOOMerang!

10 TEACHER 10
Good job Kasey! You remembered!

11 KASEY 11
Uh huh. It "came back" to me.
(giggle)

The class and Teacher laugh at Kasey's clever joke.
